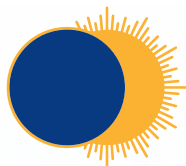

Academic Modules

Post Graduate Certificate (PgCert) in Neuro-disability Nursing Practice

The aim of the PgCert in Neuro-disability Nursing Practice is to provide flexible, contemporary Master's level education designed for registered nurses working individuals with complex neurological and neuro-disability needs across a range of care settings.

Students will engage in a critical examination of contemporary evidence, neurophysiology, alongside holistic assessment, ethical and legal considerations, and safeguarding. They will also explore the role of nursing in enhancing quality of life and outcomes for patients and their families throughout the continuum of care.

Modules include:

- Neurorehabilitation Nursing Practice
- Long-term Ventilation
- The Management of Long-term Neurological Conditions

Principles of Long-Term Neurological Care

This Level 5/6 module is designed to introduce the core principles and fundamentals of long-term neurological care and practice for Senior Healthcare Support Workers (SHCSWs), Nursing Associates (NAs) and Newly Registered Nurses (NRNs) working across a range of healthcare settings.

Continuing Professional Development Courses (CPD)

- Epilepsy Awareness with Buccal Midazolam Administration
- Recognition and Management of Deteriorating Adult (RMDA)

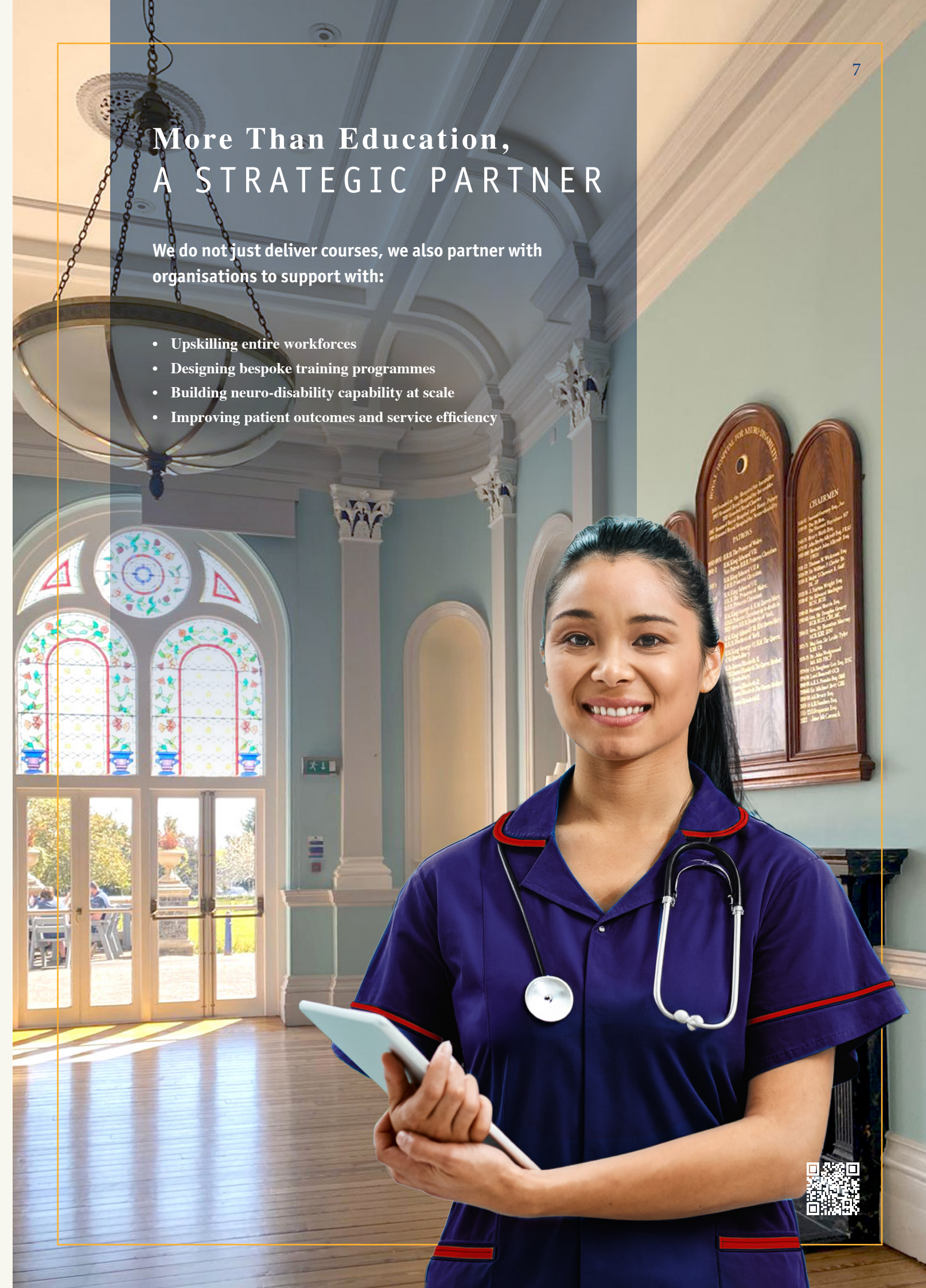
